** Terrorist attack in Vienna, 2nd November 2020 **

Period under review: from 2 November 2020 to (morning) 3 November 2020.

Situation analysis recap:

- Several attackers opened fire on residents in the centre of Vienna around 8 p.m. on the night before the implementation of lockdown measures in the fight against the Corona epidemic. This was the last evening before the lockdown and several residents visited pubs, restaurants, theatres and cinemas in the city centre.
- Locations of the attack: reportedly 6 locations, the main location is Seitenstettengasse (near Schwedenplatz). This is the second terrorist attack at this location after a Palestinian terrorist killed two people in the synagogue on this street in 1981
- According to the media outlets, at least 4 people have been killed, 15 people seriously wounded, among them one policeman. Initial indications about hostage situations were not confirmed. People were instructed to stay at home.
- According to Die Presse, it was just a matter of time before such an attack would take place in Austria.
- Key Austrian and European political figures have strongly condemned the attack.
- Austrian authorities refrain from commenting on the perpetrators and their motives.
- Counter-terrorism operation included the ordinary police, special police, EKO Cobra unit of the Federal Ministry of Internal Affairs, intelligence agencies and also the Austrian armed forces.
